I've installed Debian Woody on my laptop, an Acer Aspire 1601. After some configuring and playing with boot parameters, all is working smoothly with the exception of disk access. It takes a long time to copy large files from different directories or partitions.

I had the same problem on RedHat 7.0 and solved it by editing a hd configuration file on /etc. The file isn't there on Debian.
