Hi,

The audio/sound was working fine on my Debian Unstable box till recently. But I can't hear any sound/audio for the last 4 days. No audio for movies, mp3s, CDs, etc which used to play normally. XMMS shows that it is playing the audio files (no warnings/errors in xterm) but there is no audio. BTW, I'm using the OSS output module with XMMS which was being used earlier too.
