I've been trying out a number of editors for doc writing: conglomerate, mlview – for xml, quanta for html, and mucking round with other bits and pieces, some work to some degree.

In the end I've installed this:–

which isn't strictly a debian package, and being java based, I tried it out with kaffee only to have it segfault, so now I have to install a java variant (Blackdown 1.4, I am assuming) on my completely free sarge machine.
