Had messages frozen. Reset bounce timeout to hours. Messages unfrozen, errors ignored but messages not sent.

Posting on this list about `exim_tidydb`. Tried that. No more frozen messages but smarthost timed out and nothing was sent. Contacted the provider being used as the smarthost but these guys maybe know Windows.

Meanwhile, `exim4` is perfectly capable of being its own "provider". So for now, no more smarthost, even though it was recommended for the variable IP DNS. At least I can get mail out (to tolerant destinations?).

I googled, found no other traffic on this issue. Provider problem or new `exim4` bug?
