Hi

I'm running evolution on sarge. Before evolution 2, I used bogofilter to filter my spam, but I can't seem to get it working with evolution 2. I now use evolution 2, and always mark my spam as junk, but evolution does not seem to do any automatic filtering. To test this I made a copy of a spam mail, and marked one as junk. When I told evolution to run the junk filter on the second copy, it still did not recognise it as spam.

I do have "check incoming for junk" ticked, but not "use external filters" in the options->mail settings->junk configuration tab. How can I make evolution's spam filtering work without using external filters?
