> `5.000503 socket(PF_INET, SOCK_DGRAM, IPPROTO_IP) = 4`

That system call only creates a UDP socket (without giving it an address or doing any lookup – it just creates a "connection endpoint" on your machine, that later has to be explicitly given a name etc. with other system calls) and should return within an instant... are you sure that `_this_` is the call that takes so long? How did you check the time spent? I'd suggest using `"strace -T"`...
