- > *With kaffeine/xine the same cracking/skipping sound while playing*
- > *With kscd played perfectly*

kscd use the analog output from the cd reader (the cable that goes from the player to the sound card).

kaffeine/xine use the digital output (the ide cable).

Why digital is worse than analog. I would blame it on copy protection. The analog out have filter to remove the noise they can produce not the digital output.

You can try to rip it (soundjuicer or else) and test if the resulting mpg3 or ogg play nice.
