I'm loading Debian on a laptop machine here and both the 2.4 kernel and the 2.6 kernel included with sarge keep segfaulting on loading i810_audio, which apparently autodetection seems to think this laptop uses. (It doesn't.)

I can't seem to remember the magical incantation to tell the kernel to ignore/skip loading that module altogether.
