I'm using the i386 netinst. The ethernet card is an intel 1000gigabit ethernet pro. When I boot to the cd and go into a second terminal,

not sure exactly which 2.6.8 kernel is in the sarge install, but I still have 2.6.8-2 hanging around and it has the e1000 module, so probably a 'linux26' when booting the installer would do it. if not, then the etch install definitely will.
