I have a 3Com 3c905B that is using the 3c59x driver module, but it will only come up at 10 Mb/s instead of 100. I tried the solution listed in that link, but it doesn't see, to help. I notice that that post is rather old though. Is there a different way to set those module parameters now? Is there a better way to solve this problem now? (other than buying a new nic).

answering only to the module option part here: modinfo 3c59x shows similar options to what is mentioned in the link. But of course, that doesn't mean that some of them haven't changed meaning.
