you can 'apt-get install reportbug' (if its not installed) and use it to report bugs. This is the normal procedure for any bugs in debian. The only exception are issues with new installs or stable->stable upgrades. so, 'reportbug PKGNAME' is what you'd do. 'man reportbug' for more info.
