I've a few burning needs, so if anyone knows the answers – let me know! :D

1) I need a graphical way of searching text files for a string – and getting it to replace it (makes for easy re-configuring of files after a path change)

Most editors have a search & replace function. kedit's (kde) search & replace funtion can be activated with <CTRL> R. Gedit might be a good candidate for XFCE but I'm not sure since I have never tried it.

The 'official' Xfce text editor is mousepad, which has standard search and replace functionality (Menu -> Search -> Replace – default hotkey is ctrl-h).
