Hello,

I am trying to use taglist on my debian box. Instead of getting the script directly from:

http://www.vim.org/scripts/script.php?script_id=273

I used the debian package:

<http://packages.debian.org/stable/editors/vim-scripts>

Unfortunately there is no documentation on how to install them. For instance for taglist you are supposed to do:

...

2. Change to the \$HOME/.vim/doc or \$HOME/vimfiles/doc or \$VIM/vimfiles/doc directory, start Vim and run the ":helptags ." command to process the taglist help file. Without this step, you cannot jump to the taglist help topics.

...

Here is what I did:

```
cd /usr/share/vim-scripts/doc
vim
```

then from vim

```
:helptags .
```

which return:

```
E152: Cannot open ./tags for writing
```

Of course I can run the command as root, but is it going to work for my user than ?
