This has happened before ... Firefox and Thunderbird today started showing selected menu items as white text on a white background. I could rant for days about the stupidity of this, but what's even more exasperating is that it's next to impossible to find the place wherin I can change this in the preferences.

The "theme" of my desktop may be the culprit, but I haven't a clue what my default is, nor what will happend when I pick another one.

The change occurred after a series of resets that I had to invoke in order to escape from lockups resulting from attempts to open a large file (another question I had today).
