I'm trying to figure out what is going on here.. I've upgraded a redhat 9 machine to FC1 and the wtmp file is empty.. I've restarted syslog , rebooted the machine and nothing worked... If I run last , I have this:

```

```

the permissions seem to be right:

```
0 -rw-rw-r-- 1 root utmp 0 Mar 18 16:38 wtmp
```

```
0 -rw-rw-r-- 1 root utmp 0 Feb 20 11:15 wtmp.1x
```

This machine is heavily used , so I'm sure that the wtmp file should have lots of entries already... Any ideas?
