> *I tried running strace oowriter.....here's the end of the output where  
> it is hanging up.*

> socket(PF\_INET, SOCK\_STREAM, IPPROTO\_IP) = 27  
>fcntl64(27, F\_SETFD, FD\_CLOEXEC) = 0  
> setsockopt(27, SOL\_SOCKET, SO\_REUSEADDR, [1], 4) = 0  
> setsockopt(27, SOL\_TCP, TCP\_NODELAY, [1], 4) = 0  
> connect(27, {sa\_family=AF\_INET, sin\_port=htons(631),  
> sin\_addr=inet\_addr("64.15.205.241")}, 16) = -1 ECONNREFUSED (Connection  
> refused)  
> close(27) = 0  
>  
> *which then repeats with ther addresses 64.15.205.155, 64.15.205.180,  
> 64.15.205.202, and several others. The delay in starting is caused by  
> the timeout on all the connections. Can anybody explain what on earth is  
> happening?**
