I can't really offer any suggestions about what's going wrong here because I don't know enough about iptables rules and your setup isn't working in the same way as mine. All I can tell you is that I don't use RedHat's firewall tool (the iptables service is off) and instead I use the Projectfiles.com Linux Firewall at <http://projectfiles.com/firewall/> (download the firewall_install.sh script and run that - it'll prompt you for settings). I've got a dual-ethernet setup like yours using this firewall and am not having troubles with client machines.
