> *yum update -q(quiet) -a(ll) -n(no ask)*
> *is there such a thing??*

`yum -y update > /dev/null`
will work well from cron

If you want the results mailed to you to see what has been done just remove the redirect and the output will be sent by email.

It also can be done with the yum service, although I have not used that method.
