>> I recently bought a KVM switch (Linksys KVM2KIT) to put between a
>> Windows XP box and a Fedora 3 box. Everything was working fine on the
>> Fedora box before installing the switch. After installing the switch,
>> the monitor and keyboard worked fine on both boxes, but the mouse was
>> frozen. Rebooting the Windows box fixed the mouse problem, but on the
>> Fedora box the mouse is still frozen. I did some searching and found
>> this bug https://bugzilla.redhat.com/beta/show_bug.cgi?id=111161.
>> This seems similar, but in the bug the behavior of the mouse is
>> erratic whereas mine is frozen. I tried switching virtual terminals
>> and this did not help. I tried the "psmouse.proto=bare, =imps, etc.
>> in that bug but nothing helped. I then tried plugging the mouse
>> directly into the Fedora box, still frozen. Rebooted, still frozen.
>> Powered down, let it sit, powered up, still frozen. Not sure what to
>> do now, I could give a rat's about the Windows box right now, I just
>> want to get the Fedora box working again. Anyone have any ideas.
