I'm running KDE on FC3 using a Dell 2005FPW at 1680x1050. The problem is that it looks like its running at a much lower resolution. I know its a Linux (or xorg) problem because when I run the same resolution in Windows XP, it looks as expected: very small and sharp. Any ideas? Here is my relevant xorg.conf sections:
