try to load FC3 in text mode!! if you could provide the error log file would be helpful. when u r install fails enable the nic card and load the error file onto another machine using the scp command. the scp commands are listed in this url

u can also try this method

boot: linux text nomce

this command will disable the autoprobe of the hardware where u will have to manually select the device ... its a tedious process!!

wish u luck!!

read the scp process from that url and try to load the files to some server or some other pc. and send the error log.
