Primary IDE

hda1 Windows (C:\)

hda2 /boot

hda3 /

hdb CD-ROM

Secondary IDE

hdc1 Windows Swap (D:\)

hdc2 Linux Swap

hdd CD-Writer

Promise Ultra 100 IDE

hde1 Windows Data (E:\ - mounting this partition)

hde2 ... Linux ext3
