i'm dealing with a project where i'm going to have users deal/modify a number of docs.. i'd like some sort of doc workflow process where i can allow a given user/type of user access to the doc, and move the doc along the process.

ie,

eng -> develops the doc

test-> tests the doc

qa -> reviews the doc

doc signed off/complete...

this kind of process would have the eng/test/qa person touching the doc, and only after all have signed off on the doc, would it be complete.. i'm going to be dealing with potentially ~2000 docs, so i'd like to have a system in place that allows us to more or less track what's going on.

does anybody have any thoughts on an open source solution for this kind of situation.
