I have read that you can set up clustering on an external firewire drive connected to two Linux machines. What I don't know is how to do it – I know nothing about firewire, historically being a USB user. This is **not** for a production environment – it is for my own education at home.

What hardware do I need to use to let a single external firewire disk be accessed by two Linux servers at the same time? I figure I need the external enclosure, a firewire card for each server, and some sort of a firewire hub (if there is such a thing). Am I on the right track?
