but you can build it from the src rpm.

I'd note though that at the moment 1.0beta7 is in the development directory but that you probably want to run 1.0beta8 which you can get from dovecot.org.

dovecot is still undergoing a substantial amount of intellectual ferment at the moment which makes it kind of a moving target.
