Finally I have naively tried to use the Fn+F8 key combination (to redirect the output of the display in Windows). None of the previously stated tries worked.

Does some one of you know how to do this?

This is, for me, the most frustrating thing with running Fedora Core on my Dell D800 laptop. I cannot easily switch the display to a second monitor or display at the same time on a projector.

I have a nvidia card in this laptop and use their proprietary driver, but I still can't use the Fn+F8 key combo. What a pain in the ass.

On the bright side, FC5's hibernate and suspend work beautifully on my Toshiba Satellite 3000. I really appreciate the efforts put into getting hibernate and suspend working more reliably. I'm hopeful it will work with my D800 when I move it to FC5, too.

If you figure out the dual display problem, let me know the magic incantation. :)
