Does anyone here know when Firefox 1.5.0.5 is due to hit yum repositories? There's several major security updates[*] in this release, and with published exploits widely available it's only a matter of time before we start seeing compromised FC5 boxes.

Apparently, Firefox 1.5.0.5 is problematic (look for bug reports for RHEL4) and there will be a 1.5.0.6 RSN.
