Wasn't a big issue as it only happened a few times and was only a R&D box to play with so it could always wait until the next morning when I went in and removed the entry from host.deny. So never explored a better solution.

I'm actually in the opposite situation. I discovered the above while I was on an ISP that gave me a fixed IP address. I've since moved and am on Verizon DSL now and get my IP dynamically. Given the number of probes I get from addresses in the Verizon world, I'm not too happy with that solution at present. ;-)
