Redirect /abc <http://mycompany.com>

It means if I type <http://mycompany.com/abc> , the web browser will redirect to
<http://mycompany.com>

but if I put

Redirect <http://mycompany.uk> <http://mycompany.com>

it doesn't work at all

Take a look at using modrewrite. It allows for more complicated URL
rewriting.
