

## Re: microphone only works for first skype call under fc6

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David L wrote:

The microphone doesn't work the second time I place a call in a Skype session. If I exit skype and restart it, it works for one call again. Has anybody else seen this problem? The weird thing is that the same exact skype executable works fine from the Ubuntu live CD (I mounted my fc6 home directory from Ubuntu and ran the skype executable).

Can be some problem with Alsa, kernel or libs I guess. Use  
lsof -n | grep /dev/snd  
to see if anything has ahold of the Alsa devices. Also run  
dmesg  
to see if there's any mention of troubles.

Between skype calls, it prints nothing. I don't see any differences between the printouts on the first and second call. Except one time, it looked like artsd had opened some stuff, but that wasn't reproduceable.

dmesg didn't show anything related to sound as far as I could tell.
