Can you 'look at' (open) the DVD? Does it show one large file named <something>.iso or directories with files?

In other words did you copy the ISO to the DVD? Or did you burn an ISO image to the DVD? You should have done the second one and you should see directories and files.

By the way, I took this same disk and put it on a Dell Laptop of a friend of mine and it was able to boot the DVD successfully.
