The upgrades, with testing after each, and then scp-ing all my tweaks if I do a fresh install, also take a while — especially the one that'll require swapping out a lot of CDs.

Getting used to all the new stuff, while fascinating, is sure to take another while — even if I hold off a week or so for others of greater competence to find and fix trivia.

Yet I also have a life. I don't want to schedule a day or three of other things, including promises to friends, just when I can expect to be busiest here; nor vice-versa.

So I'm not in a hurry; but I do want to know, the further ahead the better, when the changeover is apt to come.
