Hi;

Does anybody know of or have a good little gui program, script, or command line program for printing 'info' pages. Up to now I have been using emacs + info, or cut and paste then print, or `lpr -node`.

I want something slightly more sophisticated. Print several related nodes, a whole node tree with some nodes excluded, etc.

Have googled and sourceforged. Maybe I am not using the correct search criteria ("Info print" and variations)?

I think you need the source for the info files, and then use `texi2pdf`. I haven't done this for years, so I'm not sure about the details; but `info texinfo` and `info texi2dvi` are probably good starting points.
