First I have a Bug in for the Alsa Mixer. Here is how I get it working but first let me say my headset is attached to the sound card. To see your mixer click on System Preferances Personal and at the bottom Volume Control.

Thanks Karl, but I'm using KDE, so that didn't work, however the command in my last messaage (alsamixer -c 1) did work.

Find the Micophone and by default it is turned OFF. Clear that and your mike will work.

Why is it switched off? That's crazy.

At least I know how to troubleshoot this in future.

I believe the microphone is muted by default because of feedback problems with some laptops on boot. So you have to unmute the mic, and adjust it for your system.
