Using some replication program for Linux would probably be the best option rather than DD or rsync.

If DD does not work out for you, you might try partimage or ghost 4 Linux. I am not sure if rsync would be successful. I did read a mention by Alan regarding rsync -a being an option after already have posted a response to this thread.
