I'm trying to remove xdg-user-dirs as mentioned in Section 10.1 of the release notes and what looks like most of KDE is going to be removed as well. Is there a way around it as I want KDE but not the xdg-user-dirs folders in my \$HOME

I agree that the xdg-user-dirs function is a feature that I could do without, and having it enabled by default is indeed a nuisance of the first order.

To disable it, edit either /etc/xdg/user-dirs.conf or ~/.config/user-dirs.conf to include enabled=False
