I'd like to start Firefox on a remote machine (FC5) and have it display locally (F7). But whenever I try, a new window of the locally running FF comes up. It seems that the startup script is too clever (or I'm too dumb). (DISPLAY is fine, I can use other remote X programs without problems.)

Try:

```
MOZ_NO_REMOTE=1 firefox
```

Presuming there's no firefox running for that user on the remote machine.

Thanks, this is it!

The only problem is that it works only if there's no firefox running `_locally_` for the user with the same username as the remote one's. But

```
MOZ_NO_REMOTE=1 firefox -P default
```

solves that problem, too.
