Having some audio problems with VLC in Fedora 8. While listening to mp3 radio stations, the sound will eventually become blasts of white noise. Also, mp4 files (such as iTunes store files with DRM) are choppy.

I'm using the livna vlc files:

```
vlc-core-0.8.6d-3.lvn8  
vlc-0.8.6d-3.lvn8
```

No such problems with xmms:

```
xmms-mp3-1.2.10-5.lvn6  
xmms-faad2-2.0-21.20050131.lvn8  
xmms-libs-1.2.10-36.fc7  
xmms-1.2.10-36.fc7
```

That is the new pulseaudio problem. I found out how to remove at least part of it and my VLC is working fine in F8 again.
