I have just installed Mathematica 6.0.3, but when try to run it, I get the following error:

«An error has occurred while Mathematica was starting up. Mathematica may not function properly until this problem is resolved. You may choose to continue anyway, but you could encounter additional problem.»

Any ideas?

Last I'd heard, Ver 6 wouldn't run on Linux. Just now, I found this on their website:

Linux x86

Linux 2.4 or later  
32-bit, 64-bit

Mathematica 6 has been fully tested on all major Linux distributions based on the 2.4 Linux kernel. On newer Linux distributions, additional compatibility libraries may need to be installed.

So, I'd guess that you're going to have to research what those additional libs might be...

Thanks, Claude. I have done some research, but no success. I posted a message on the Mathematica newsgroup, but nobody has replied so far.

Has someone on the list ever succeeded with running Mathematica 6.0.3 on F9?

Someone, meanwhile, has suggested to me to install
