When I log in remotely to gdm via VNC, all goes well. However, when I select xdmcp, or vnc session ?

most of the items under Gnome's System / Administration menu nothing happens.

Is this issue reproducible locally, w/o vnc ?

I am running as root. Here's the output from the process on my box:
