Hey,

i was trying to set ld_library_path in gnome session for my login. I was unable to do so by adding the variable in .bash_profile.

```
$ gconftool-2 --set -t boolean \  
/apps/gnome-terminal/profiles/Default/login_shell true
```

You may also consider putting that in your export in your .gnomerc file, too

Try using

```
$ LD_LIBRARY_PATH=/some/path gedit
```

for an example to run Gedit with LD_LIBRARY_PATH set.
