I noticed that some core desktop applications (e.g. eog, gedit and others like gthumb) are calling stat64 on /etc/localtime 6150 times on shutdown. I couldn't dig any information on what causes that call, so I don't know where to start looking. Apparently it doesn't affect non-Gnome GTK+ apps such as Gimp, qalculate or Synaptic.

I'm sorry to be quoting myself, but it seems that the stat comes from gtk_recent_info_get_modified, which is also being called over 6000 times.

I would still appreciate pointers on where to take this issue from here.
