Thank You, but why windows+t (or windows+other key) to run terminal work's fine?

Because that particular shortcut is handled by metacity, not g-s-d.

And that means you could accomplish what you want with some GConf fiddling. In the Configuration Editor, look at `/apps/metacity/global_keybindings/run_command_$i` for `$i` from 1 to 12. Set one of these to the appropriate string representation of `Window+L`.

(Look at what's set for `run_command_terminal` for the correct form, since that's already working for you.)

Then go to `/apps/metacity/keybinding_commands` and set the corresponding `command_$i` to

`gnome-screensaver-command --lock`
