If this gets posted correctly, it will patch
[...]/drivers/char/defkeymap.c_shipped
and
[...]/drivers/char/defkeymap.mapped
so that keys \| and _ will work for both Japanese PS/2 and Japanese USB
keyboards.

I did not develop the patch in the same way as was done by junkio@cox.net
(sorry I misplaced his real name somewhere), but am trying to post it in
the same manner as he posted his on July 23, 2003.

Sorry I use Monopolysoft for most internet stuff so I cannot mail this by
an ordinary method. Outlook Express changes each tab to a single space.
So I'm using the telnet command to submit this mail. Odds are that the
LKML's spam controls will detect that and reject this message, but I'll
try anyway, in hopes of preserving tab characters.
