> *Are you considering including libata support for 2.4.24? From my  
> testing with a number of different embedded sata chipsets (mostly ICH,  
> SI, and Promise) it appears very stable. I'm not seeing any data  
> corruption or lockups when running Cerberus with 2.4.23-rc5 + libata  
> patch. The only troubles I've had were with initialization of embedded  
> promise sata controllers. (I still need to test with Jeff's latest fixes  
> for this.)*

I'm happy to include it in 2.4 when Jeff thinks its stable enough for a stable series. ;)
