Jens Axboe writes:

- > *Your problem is that DMA is disabled. I don't know why you say that*
- > *hdparm doesn't work for you, how are you running it? I'm assuming that*
- > */dev/cdrom is linked to /dev/hdc (or where is your CDROM located?).*

You're right... dma is disabled... for all my drives. Some change between booting up in 2.4 vs 2.6. I have no idea why... yet.

And hdparm does work fine on /dev/cdrom. I did something stupid (ran /sbin/hdparm as a normal user) which made me think it didn't.
