Could I ask anyone with a USB Zip drive and a ps2 mouse to try to confirm this bizarre bug for me?

To reproduce it should be simple:

- 1) Compile USB support as modular, **not** compiled in.
- 2) The USB Zip drive **must** be plugged in during boot.
This bug won't show if you plug in the drive later.
- 3) Reboot and see if your ps2 mouse works.
