> BLUETOOTH dongle. If I start up the System with the DONGLE the System works  
> fine, even if BLUETOOTH did not work, if I remove the Dongle the systems  
> hangs. If I plug the Dongle into an running System I receive the following  
> messages:*

I've the very same problem, noticed for the first time in the last 2.5.X and first 2.6.0-pre releases.

I'll can recover my e-mail on this list, or make new tests.

Have you tried to turn off SCO support? IIRC the bug is related to this feature.

I've also some oopses obtained with serial console, but I'll try to reproduce this issue and capture new oopses with 2.6.5 kernels.
