In the latest 2.4 and 2.6 kernels, Documentation/sysrq.txt seems to still mention that MAGIC SYSRQ is still available, however I can not find it in the configuration. When I add CONFIG_MAGIC_SYSRQ to .config and run oldconfig, it vanishes.

What is the preferred method of enabling magic sysrq on i386? That was a really nice feature. I hope it has not been removed.
