- > This patch contains the following cleanups:
- > - move the help text to the right option
- > - replace some #ifdef's in capi.c with dummy functions in capifs.h
- > - use CONFIG_ISDN_CAPI_CAPIFS_BOOL in one place in capi.c

I actually still like to see capifs removed completely. It is not really needed if you gonna use udev. The only thing that it is doing, is to set the correct permissions and make sure that the device nodes are created. And with a 2.6 kernel this can be all done by udev.
